ORYX [®] Grafite FR is an acrylic sealant that expands under pressure in the event of fire and creates a seal for plastic pipes (up to 55 mm diameter), plastic and steel pipes fitted with flammable insulation, and bundled cable penetrations.
 Small-diameter plastic pipes in fire-resistant walls Around steel pipes with flammable insulation Around steel pipes and other small penetrations, including cable bundles
 Features of ORYX® Grafite FR include: Fire-resistant up to four hours Maintains acoustic performance of the partition Independently proven and tested to the requirements of EN 1366-3:2009 Outstanding adhesion to the most common surfaces, including porous materials, without the use of primers Easy to use, water-based for rapid drying and easy cleaning Can be painted when dry Odourless and halogen-free Creates smoke-tight and airtight seal
 Surface to be sealed must be clean, dry and dust-free Apply between +5°C and +30°C Use mineral wool backing to control the joint depth Ensure the opening is completely filled to the required depth Finish the sealant with a dry trowel within five minutes of applying Store in a cool, dry place at temperatures between +2°C and +30°C. Protect against frost

ORYX® Grafite FR is not suitable for use underwater, such as in swimming pools or aquariums, or for applications in structural glazing, and it should not could come into contact with food.
